What you need to know about parent vaccinations

Common Myths and Honest Facts about Vaccines

Myth: Many major illnesses have disappeared so vaccines are no longer necessary.

Fact: Many communities still have outbreaks of certain diseases such as Measles or Pertussis (whooping cough), so it is best to be vaccinated to avoid spreading the disease to others.

Myth: The flu is not harmful enough to get a vaccine against it unless you are very young or elderly.

Fact: Thousands of people of all ages are hospitalized or killed from the flu each year, even seemingly young and healthy people.

Myth: The flu vaccine can give you the flu and the Tdap vaccine can give you Tetanus, Diphtheria or Pertussis.

Fact: The flu vaccine and Tdap vaccine both contain a dead virus so it cannot make you sick.

Why are Vaccines Important?

Pertussis is a severely contagious respiratory disease that is commonly referred to as whooping cough which causes violent coughing making it hard to breathe.

Diphtheria is a respiratory disease causing sore throat and fever. Tetanus can cause muscle spasms and lockjaw.

The flu is a contagious seasonal virus that involves fever, body aches, vomiting and many other unpleasant symptoms.

Even before babies are old enough to get their shots, they can get sick. When parents get vaccinated they are protecting their children and those around them from diseases especially dangerous to the very young and elderly. Often adults who get their shots as children have not gotten the booster shots. Without this protection, they can get serious illnesses too.

How Much Does it Cost?
